

Buckingham



How to find us

Buckingham Hospital is situated in its own grounds close to the town centre on the High Street.

By Road:

From Aylesbury: Take the A413 Aylesbury to Buckingham Road. As you enter Buckingham you will come to a mini roundabout with Tesco on your left. Go straight over (2nd exit) the mini roundabout. At the next roundabout go right (3rd exit). At the next roundabout take the 1st exit. At the next roundabout go straight over (2nd exit). At the next roundabout take the 1st exit. Go down the hill, pass BP petrol station on your left, road narrows. Then after approx 50 yards, take right turn signposted Hospital. The hospital is located behind a rank of bus stops located directly in front. (If you come to the Old Gaol House, you have passed the entrance).

Public Transport:

Bus Routes: Bus routes 18, 32, 32A, 60, 131, 132, 133, 134, 151, 632, MCS1 and OCC6 stop close to the hospital on the High Street.

Parking:

There is a small car park at the hospital, which is free of charge, with allocated disabled bays.

Reception:

Please follow the signs for Entrance 2 – physiotherapy.
