Fully wheelchair accessible

The residents' areas are situated over two floors, with a lift to the first floor. All corridors are equipped with handrails and the home is fully wheelchair accessible throughout.



Entertaining guests

Friends and relatives can be entertained either in one of our lounges, or in the privacy of the resident's own room. Guests are very welcome to stay for lunch or supper and, for those special occasions, our chef will be delighted to arrange something exceptional.

Please note that Chalfont Court is non-smoking throughout.

Friendly, caring staff

As with all our care homes, staff at Chalfont Court are chosen just as much for their compassionate and caring natures as for their qualifications and experience. And, to ensure each individual's care plan and needs are fully met, every resident is appointed their own Key Worker.

An active, independent life

There is a regular programme of organised activities at Chalfont Court, designed to cover a wide range of interests, from bingo to singing, to painting. There are also trips out to places of interest, such as the London Eye or Kew Gardens. It is up to everyone to choose just how they wish to spend the day: there is no fixed routine and no obligation to get involved.

A wide range of services

Residents benefit from a number of services, including those of a visiting hairdresser, chiropodist, optician, dietician and GP. A dentist comes as and when required. There is also a mobile library and a personal laundry service. We maintain close links with our local community, so churches, schools and local groups are regularly invited to participate in the life of the home. A religious minister also visits weekly to ensure the residents' pastoral and spiritual needs are met.

Type of care

Chalfont Court provides nursing care for residents with dementia, as well as those who have elderly care needs. We also provide considerable support for the relatives of our residents, as we regard family members very much as part of our home.
